

KOMATSU DASH 8 EXCAVATORS ARRIVE IN IRELAND



CMH Construction & Civil Engineering last week took delivery of a Komatsu PC138US-8. The Dash 8 range was recently launched at Komatsu UK in Newcastle to the European market and Kerry based C.M.H. are the first in Ireland to take delivery of this model. C.M.H.
